AGINCOURT RIBBON REEFS

Silversonic has the largest selection of over 35 stunning and exclusive World Heritage reef sites at Agincourt Reef at the very outer edge of the Great Barrier Reef. Here, special reefs known as 'ribbons' run parallel to the Continental Shelf. Adjacent to the Coral Sea trench, these ribbon reefs are recognised as the most pristine eco-systems in the reef's environment. Clear water provides the best possible underwater visibility, encourages rich coral growth and supports spectacular marine life.



SWIM WITH THE MINKES!

Silversonic has one of the few permits from the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Authority that allows our guests to swim with dwarf minke whales if encountered - a truly unforgettable experience! These inquisitive creatures are frequently sighted around the Agincourt reefs during the months of May to September. Their larger cousins, the humpback whales, are frequently sighted from around July during their annual migration to mate and birth in our tropical waters.

Advice for Water Activities

Certain medical conditions and medications may preclude some people from introductory and certified diving. For advice and more information, contact our office or see our website. The minimum age for introductory scuba diving is 12 years, however some older age persons may require a doctor's certificate. After a single dive a wait of 12 hours is recommended before ascending to an altitude of 300 metres or greater. If doing multiple dives an interval of 24 hours is suggested. Snorkelling can be a strenuous activity. Please use caution and inform our crew of any medical conditions. Certified divers must have proof of certification.

Conditions

On very rare occasions, services can be subject to the effect of weather or unforeseen circumstances requiring changes to the brochured itinerary. Should Silversonic not operate for any reason passengers will be offered an alternative day or a refund authorised. Cancellation fees may apply, please check at time of booking. All fares are in Australian Dollars and include GST. Prices valid to 31 March 2027.
